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Stirring the Waters | Between Two Bodies Cleveland Sculptors in Boston

Boston Sculptors Gallery is excited to announce the first contemporary sculpture exchange between Boston, MA and Cleveland, OH. **The Sculpture Center Director Ann Albano** selected artworks by 10 Boston Sculptors Gallery member artists to show at The Sculpture Center and **12 artists closely affiliated with The Sculpture Center to show at Boston Sculptors Gallery**. She curated work that exemplifies particular responses in the two regions to a broad range of the aesthetic and conceptual concerns of contemporary sculpture.

The Sculpture Center affiliated artists will exhibit at the Boston Sculptor's Gallery from July 5 – August 12, 2012. These are Jake Beckman, Elizabeth Emery, Sarah Kabot, Lauren Kalman, Irina Koukhanova, Paul O'Keeffe, Nancy Prudic, Kristin Rogers, Mark Soppeland, Robert Thurmer, Charles Tucker, and Christian Wulffen.

There will be an Artists' Reception on July 6 from 5:30 -8:30 pm with an Artists' Talk at 6 pm.

Several of the Cleveland artists reference the built environment using common construction materials, such as plywood, plaster, roofing tar, and sand, combined with other media and markedly non-high art materials to convey abstract concepts. Sound, video, light, and motion also predominate. This original use of all manner of materials, from traditional cast bronze and painted steel to highly varied mixed media and fabric constructions, is representative of much contemporary 3-D work and underscores the many varied, originally conceived options used by contemporary sculptors.

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
