

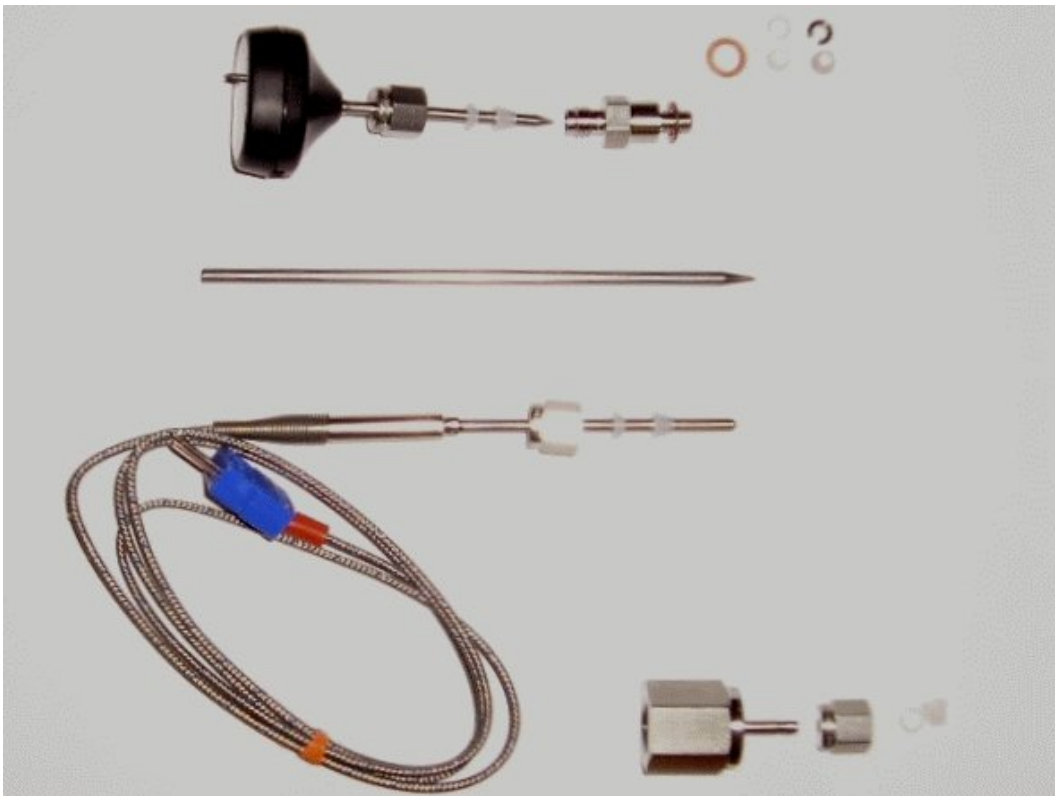

Please read and, perhaps, reread the document(s) on the above FTP site for the item(s) you intend to purchase. Many, if not all of the answers to questions which may come to mind are contained there. However, feel free to ask all the questions you want either via e-mail or phone. I have “standardized” on the thermometer kit I offer to customers worldwide and that is based on the Taylor 524 thermometer which offers soft push switchability between C & F readings. While there are only four 3516 thermometers left, these will continue to be supported.

I do accept PayPal and my PayPal email is my normal email - erics@erols.com Please note that the PayPal fee should be added to your amount in the amount as shown in the next section. If you are within the United States, please add approximately 3.5% to the total bill. If you are domiciled outside of the United States, please add approximately 4.5% as the fee which includes PayPal’s cross-border/ currency conversion charges **or see the next section to calculate the exact amount.**

Shipping

Shipping within the United States is normally via United States Postal Service (USPS) 1st Class mail and the cost is included in the price of the goodies. Out of several hundred mailings, there have been **ZERO** lost packages but three lengthy deliveries (~12 days – go figure) within the US. Canadian orders can also be mailed via USPS 1st Class international mail for an additional \$5.00 charge, due mainly to the time required to fill out the customs form and the fact that this requires a wait in line as compared to simply putting the package in the box at the post office for US delivery.

Shipping outside of the United States can be accomplished using one of two available methods. These are USPS Priority Mail and USPS Express Mail. The quoted delivery time for Priority Mail is 6-10 **business days** and that for Express Mail is 3-5 **business days**. The additional cost for Priority Mail, using a 9.5” x 12.5” flat rate envelope, is \$20. This covers the time it takes to fill out the customs form(s) and post office line time. **Unfortunately, this service does not provide tracking for either you or me.**

The other shipping option is USPS Express Mail which has a fee of \$35 using a flat rate envelope similar to the Priority Mail envelope. This covers the time it takes to hand type the customs form(s), express mail shipping label, and post office line time. **The advantage to Express Mail International is that it is trackable and makes a lot of sense – even more so if this is a high value order.** As regards all non-US postal rates, your cost is my cost plus an amount for the extra time involved unless there are unusual circumstances (large order requiring a box) for which you will be advised beforehand.

PayPal Fees or a Review of Elementary Algebra (grin)

Let X = the amount the buyer (that’s you) sends
 Let Y = the amount that Eric (that’s me) wants in his pocket (including the stated amount going to CoffeeKids)

Typical examples of “Y” would be 45, 68, or 81 (as taken from the price list)

Now, **AS AN EXAMPLE**, lets assume you are an espresso nut, domiciled in the US, that wants a stainless steel thermocouple adaptor. You see from the price list that I want \$68.00.

$X - .029X - 0.30 = 68$ **OR, SIMPLIFYING,** $0.971 X = 68.30$

THEREFORE: X = \$70.34 (the amount you tell Paypal you want to send)

Price List Says (\$)	You Tell Paypal (\$)

If you live outside of the United States, Paypal charges me 3.9% plus 0.30 cents.

HERE’S ANOTHER EXAMPLE:

You are an espresso nut domiciled in Australia that wants a stainless steel digital thermometer kit with the Taylor 524 reading in both Celsius and Fahrenheit. You see from the price list that I want \$97.00. So:

$X - .039X - 0.30 = 97 + 20$ (USPS Priority shipping)

$0.961X = 117.30$

THEREFORE: X = \$122.06 (the amount you tell Paypal you want to send)

Warranty

For the first 30 days – full refund of monies exclusive of postage and CoffeeKids donation will be made upon your request **AND** upon receipt of product.

The thermometer, attached probe, and any purchased accessories are guaranteed to be fully functional for 1 year from the date of purchase. Replacements during this time period will be made for the cost of postage, shipping supplies, and a small “handling” fee - \$10.00 **AND** upon receipt of old unit. Replacement units will ship with one set of new ferrules and nut. You are obligated to return the old parts (nut and ferrules and thermometer)

If the thermometer was purchased directly from me, no receipt is required – I retain all e-mails. If the thermometer was purchased from Chris’ Coffee, an order number or some other validated document showing the purchase date is required.

The stainless steel and brass adaptors, excluding the ferrules and copper washers, are warranted to the original purchaser for life.
