Notes for EMIL NIESSEN:

Emil emigrated from Germany in the 1890's and settled in the Germantown area of Philadelphia. After his marriage to Theresa Serwazi in 1907, they lived for many years at 5521 Green St, then at 6321 McCallum St. Emil was one of the founders of Quaker Chemical Products, Corp in Conshohocken, PA. He chose to be heavily involved in the sales side of the business, and therefore spent a great deal of time on the road. After selling the business, he bought a tobacco farm in Faulkner, MD, where he lived with his second wife, Toni. The farm, Sodus Manor, was quite large, and was worked by resident tenant farmers. There was also a live-in maid and a boxer named Mike.

Emil was a stamp collector. The bulk of his collection was sold prior to the purchase of Sodus Manor, but he also gave part of his collection to his grandchildren. I remember him as a deliberate speaker with excellent English. The only sign of his native German was his use of the filler (to give himself more time to translate) "you see..."

Vera rushed her to the doctor who washed out her eyes, saving her sight. She lived in family operated bars (tap rooms) in Philadelphia until marriage to Philip Niessen in November of 1940. Growing up, Eleanor spent summers in Ocean City, NJ and Ventnor, NJ (6 N. Oxford Ave). She attended St. Malachy's School (Grammar), Wagner Public School and finally Mercy Academy where she finished first in her class. Eleanor designed her high school ring (also one side of her college ring).
